Welcome to our second 2008 newsletter.

Saturday 21st June meeting

We are on our way to establishing our plant nursery. Our next members' meeting will be held at 2.00pm on Saturday, 21st June 2008 so that every one can see the location of the proposed Nursery in the former North Head School of Artillery.

New Secretary

We are delighted to welcome our new secretary, Kathy Ridge. Kathy's background is in environmental law and she was previously a director of NSW Nature Conservation Council.

Thank you

Judith Bennett retired as our Hon Secretary last year, after five years of valued service. She continues to be an active Committee member.

Interesting information

Nick Skelton, Director of GIS Environmental Consultants, gave a fascinating talk at last meeting about North Head flora and fauna: North Head has a large Aeolian sand deposit – this is pure white sand that has low phosphorous and nitrogen levels. It does not suit many weeds but it supports the Eastern Suburbs Banksia Scrub Community.

A big problem for the vegetation of the area is caused when rats, which are not native to the area, eat seed before it can germinate. Controlling rat numbers is difficult.

Natural environment management

The Australian Wildlife Conservancy Operational Plan for North Head Sanctuary has been accepted and the successful tender for the wildlife management will be announced soon.

Reconstruction of the Arch

Banksia ericifolia



Banksia ericifolia (Photo by Jenny Wilson) is in flower now on North Head. It naturally occurs on North Head and has large striking spikes of reddish-yellow flowers that contrast well with its small linear leaves. Did you know that Banksia was named in honour of Sir Joseph Banks? Propagation is by seed or by cuttings.

Did you know that *Banksia ericifolia* is relatively resistant to *Phytophthora cinnamomi*? *Phytophthora cinnamomi* causes dieback in mixed native plant communities.

North Head Sanctuary Foundation aims:
