Acacia terminalis subsp terminalis



or Sunshine Wattle is an endangered species that is found on North Head. It is also is a species characteristic of ESBS.

It is a shrub to 5 metres tall and has wider seed pods, thicker stalks bearing the flower heads and is hairier than the common Sunshine wattle - *Acacia terminalis ssp augustifolia*.

It can be seen in flower now until July.
